FOUNDATIONS BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES

Foundations BHS provides professional assessment, treatment, and support services for behavioral health disorders for Mercer County and surrounding areas. Foundations provides services for mental health, substance use, medication, and case management as well as school-based and group counseling services, including summer programming. Staff is available to attend meetings with parents/teachers/clients to discuss services and share information.

Services Provided: Services are primarily billed to Medicaid, Medicare and/or private insurance. A sliding scale fee is available for those individuals who reside in Mercer, Van Wert and Paulding counties.

Eligibility: New client Open Access Hours (Walk in Assessments)

Foundations: Monday 1:30-3:30 PM, Tuesday/Wednesday 9:30-10:30 AM, Thursday 1:30-4:30 PM

Foundations Recovery Clubhouse: Friday 12:30-2:30 PM

New clients are asked to bring insurance cards, proof of household income and a photo ID. Those 18 or younger must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
